

Instructions for payment of NTREM registration fee

Unlike in previous years we have introduced registration fee of 50 EUR for Junior and 100 EUR for senior authors and participants if paid before January 31st, 2019. After this date it will be 200 EUR irrespective of the seniority.

The reason was to minimize the number of registered abstracts not followed by full text (paper registration) and also minimize number of registered participants that did not arrive (participant registration).

Important:

Everyone participating in NTREM is expected to pay only once – either as main author of a paper or as a participant.

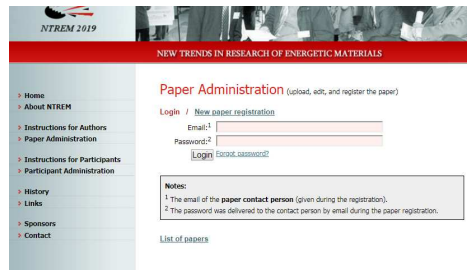
Examples:

- You are a main author of paper and will arrive to Pardubice – pay the paper registration do not pay again as participant
- You are a co-author and will arrive to Pardubice – pay as participant
- You are main author but will not come to Pardubice, however your co-author will – pay for the paper and let us know by-email (we will use the paper fee for the co-author)
- You are author of a paper and none will come to Pardubice – pay for the paper
- You are co-author of more than one paper and will arrive to Pardubice – pay only once as participant
- You are co-author and will not come to Pardubice – do not pay anything
- You are a sponsor – do not pay anything

Authors are expected to submit the full text and have the fee paid before January 31st, 2019 to ensure the paper inclusion in the program.

Payment for the paper – done by main author, preferably the one presenting the work in Pardubice

1. Go to paper administration and login using the password provided during registration



2. You will see a pay button (visible only after acceptance of your abstract)

3. Pressing this button takes you to University Marketplace, where we have prepared registration as an item. Based on the seniority you should be automatically linked and see the price being paid (junior 50 EUR, senior 100 EUR, after deadline 200 EUR).




